Minutes of the meeting April 4, 2007

3. **Membership: Mary Ann Weingartner:** we have now 130 members.

We would have to enter all the names of the members. There is such a group, the Google group, set up by Marijke and she will check if they have a poll possibility.

5. Relay for Life (Saturday June 23): Doris Lehr

There are no objections to change the date and run the June tournament on June 10. Frank Smyth agreed to run this Combo Doubles Tournament. The purpose is to make money, but how? If we explain that the contribution is for a charitable event, that 50% goes to Relay of Life, we could increase the entry fee (\$25).

On that day we have to make sure all the courts are available, and fill them all. According to Bill Powell we can easily double the number of participants, like we did in the past.

We can do this by making publicity. We will have sign-up sheets at the General Meeting.

There will be an ad in the Town Crier, and we will use our newsletter and website.

Another idea to make money: a raffle at the tournament.

6. Public Relations: Pat Frischmann

Pat Frischmann : we also have to thank Jane Turnbull and her friend for getting the ball rolling. They sent emails to the council and the school board complaining about the locked courts.

She and Beth Watt met with the principal, with Joe White and the maintenance director. They agreed on everything except unlocking the gates.

The LA High School asked our help in lobbying the town to pay for maintenance costs. Pat and Beth reminded the school that LATC donated nets two years ago.

The board members agree that it would be a good idea to help the school if we could get more access to the courts.

Mary Ann W.: this looks like a hostage situation!

And what about the money they don't have to spend on the two courts they are demolishing? They could shift that money to the school and open more courts for public access.

Tom G: the club never made any promises when the courts needed resurfacing, and when the HS asked for our support. There was definitely some miscommunication; the HS is convinced we promised to help but reproach we never followed through.

The HS also reproaches the city that they reneged on their promises to repair the lights. There is a lot of resentment but the main question is: DO WE WANT TO HELP THE HS?

If we do, it will be for strategic reasons: we need those tennis courts

If not, it is because we don't like the hostage situation.

General feeling: we should be on the side of the HS

But at the same time encourage and urge the town to do the maintenance of the courts.

Pat F. will write a letter to the town.
